In November 2018 Mary's Mercy Center through its Mary's Table and Mary's Children provided the following services;

Meals served: 5,760 (includes lunches for parolees)

Food Bags: 522 (over 3 Wednesdays)

Showers (including a change of clothes): 360 Hygiene kits: 327 plus 116 shaving kits

Hair Cuts: 9

Clothing (2-4 outfits and shoes): 181 of which 167 were for extreme emergencies.


Thursday Giveaway: 550 individuals & families
